Jefferson Community Pool Rules:

- All pool users must follow all established pool rules.
- All pool users must follow the guidelines set forth by the lifeguards on duty.
- Any swimmer may be asked, at any time, to perform a swim test before entering the deep end. If the test cannot be passed, the swimmer can retake it as soon as the next day.
 - The test requires that the swimmer must be able to swim across the pool doing front and back crawl.
- No inflatable objects will be allowed at any time. This includes, but is not limited to: water wings, inflatable rings, inflatable mattresses, etc.
- All swimmers, no matter the age, that are in a life jacket must have a responsible adult within arm's reach in the water at all times.
- All non-swimmers must have a responsible adult in the water and within arm's reach at all times.
- No person under the influence of drugs or alcohol is permitted into the pool.
- Use of tobacco or "vape pens" are not allowed within the confines of the pool.
- Pool noodles should be used for fun, not as an aid for a patron that cannot swim. If a non-swimmer is using a noodle, they must have an adult in the water and within arm's reach at all times.
- All swimmers wearing life jackets must be assisted by a responsible adult while using the slide.
- No swimmer under 40 pounds is permitted on the slide.
- No lifejackets or noodles are permitted in the deep end.
- The lifeguards have the final say.
